Harmony Hill



Harmony Hill, our first upright monument garden, now provides families the opportunity to memorialize a loved one with a one-of-a-kind granite monument. This exclusive garden spans seven acres amid rolling hills and a picturesque view of the neighboring golf course. Harmony Hill is comprised of eight individual sections appropriately named after the tree species planted in each garden. A granite trellis feature placed at the tree-lined entrance allows for placement of cremated remains. Harmony Hill is the ideal garden for families interested in both traditional in-ground burial and above ground inurnment options.

Tranquility Cremation Garden



Our new cremation area in Tranquility, a 7-acre, Asian-inspired garden in the tradition of Feng-Shui, is now available. Families may memorialize their loved ones with a choice of three beautiful bronze flower memorials designed for both companion

and individual sets of cremated remains.

Also available for cremation placement is our pagoda niche, cremation benches and pedestals lining the flower-filled walkway.
