Winter Safety Tips

Winter is here! Please remember these tips from the ASPCA for keeping your furry family members warm and safe this season.

- Keep your home humidified and towel dry your pet as soon as he comes inside.
- Never shave your dog down to the skin, as a longer coat provides more warmth.
- After each walk, wash and dry your pet's feet and stomach to remove ice or salt.
- Bathe your pets as little as possible during cold spells to minimize dry skin.
- Feed your pet a bit more during the cold months to provide needed calories.
- Remember, if it's too cold for you, it's probably too cold for your pet.

Pet Transport Service


After the passing of a beloved pet, grieving pet parents may feel uneasy or, for any reason, unable to bring their pet to Dulaney Valley from their home or veterinarian's office. Our pet transport service is especially helpful for pet families needing assistance and available 7 days a week for a nominal fee.

Pet Sanctuary & Faithful Friends



With the addition of Pet Sanctuary, our pet gardens have expanded in the number of traditional ground spaces, as well as cremation burial options with our octagonal granite columbarium. A memorial wall accepts bronze plaques in memory of pets not interred within the garden.

Adjacent to Pet Sanctuary, Faithful Friends is the region's first cemetery garden allowing the burial of both pet parents and their pets. Each lot contains a space for one pet to be laid to rest at the foot of the pet parent's space.



Interment fees, vaults, caskets, and bronze or granite memorials are readily available. All arrangements may be made in advance for your peace of mind.

Our office hours are Monday - Friday from 8:30 - 5:00pm and Saturday from 9:00 - 3:00pm. Sunday by appointment only.
