

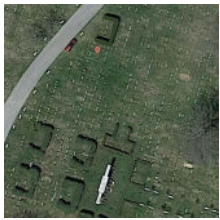

Burial Search & Memorial Webpages



Burial Search

We are pleased to announce that grave locations for all loved ones resting at Dulaney Valley Memorial Gardens may now be found by family and friends using our updated burial search. Visit our website and click "Burial Search" in the menu to search by name. Under the location information, click "Get Directions" to view it on your desktop or phone (IOS and Android).

Memorial Webpages

Each loved one resting at Dulaney Valley Memorial Gardens (1958 to present) has a complimentary memorial webpage for family and friends to post memories and photos revealing their loved one's legacy. You may search for a loved one by name in the online burial search, and under the location, click "View & Submit Memories." Memories are displayed chronologically on a custom page with social sharing links. (Please allow one week from the memorial service date for recent interments.) We hope this new benefit provides support along your grief journey.



Veteran Columbarium



A new granite columbarium inscribed with the words "All Gave Some, Some Gave All, and to Serve was an Honor" stands amid our Holy Cross and Field of Honor gardens with a backdrop of the Circle of the Immortals. A columbarium contains multiple cremation niches, in this case, 72 niches. The bronze soldier atop the monument kneels in reverence to the battlefield cross, an impactful tribute to our veterans.

Harmony Hill Columbaria

In the heart of Harmony Hill, three columbaria are featured in the circle facing the trellis with panoramic views of the lake or adjacent golf course. Each gray granite columbarium holds 72 cremation niches for a total of 216 opportunities to share in the beauty of Harmony Hill.

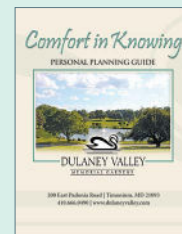
